Important Information – Response Starting May 11, 2020

The new coronavirus infection countermeasure was announced by the national government and the prefecture. The declaration of emergency has been extended, and it is necessary to take thorough measures to limit transmission. In addition, the response in each city and town in this prefecture seems to be different.

Therefore, at present, in response to the prevention of the spread of infection by Nagasaki Prefecture, we will be implementing the following measures.

- 1 From May 11 (Mon) May 16 (Sat) In-School Days (Distributed School) will be held.
 (On days when students are not scheduled to physically come to school, it will be treated as a temporary holiday.)
 (1) Junior high school: May 11 (Mon), 13 (Wed) and 15 (Friday) (no school for elementary school students)
 (2) Elementary school: May 12 (Tue), 14 (Thu), 16 (Sat) (no school for junior high school students)
 O As usual, school days will be from 8:10 to 16:00. Students are scheduled to leave school at 16:00.

 May 16th (Sat): 1/2 day. Students are scheduled to leave school at 12:30
 O On days students are not schedule to come to school, we will hold "remote classes" using tablets. (Details will be given by the homeroom teacher)
 O Lunch will be provided for children and students on school days. (There is no lunch for children attending Hanazono Kids Club on school holidays)
 OThe school bus will run normally in the morning and leave school at 16:00. There will be no 18:00 bus.
 O Regarding school bus use, to avoid the 3 C's, we would appreciate it if you could help by making different
- transportation arrangements when possible.

 O There is no after school study for junior high school students.
- OAbout use daycare (elementary school students only)

As in the past, a special "special daycare" and *Hanazono Kids Club* (afternoon) was implemented to support families in need. Due to the Declaration of Emergency by the national and prefectural governments, please consider carefully before using it.

There will be special daycare provided for elementary students are on the morning of the 11th, 13th, and 15th.

To use the special daycare, please contact the school by tomorrow 8th (Friday). (37-8100)

Alternatively, you can also send us an email from the school website with the school representative email.

The *Hanazono Kids Club* can be used from the afternoon. In that case, please prepare your own lunch.
